## Art Market San Francisco Returns for its Highly Anticipated 10th Edition from April 21st through 24th

**San Francisco, CA** -- A testament to its respected tradition and the dedicated local arts community, [Art Market San Francisco](#) - the Bay Area's premier and longest-running art fair - will return to the [Fort Mason Center for Arts & Culture's Festival Pavilion from April 21st through 24th](#), for the fair's highly anticipated 10th edition.

With a renewed sense of community and a truly palatable excitement by collectors, curators, and art lovers alike at seeing the esteemed fair return after a two year pandemic-impacted hiatus, this year's event is slated to rival 2019, which saw record breaking sales, city-wide partnerships, and attendance of over 28,000.
